Part 1: Nomination Information

Being a member of the Board of Directors of the Toronto Concert Band is an opportunity for representatives of the band membership and the community abroad to contribute their knowledge, energy and commitment to the well-being of the TCB.

Your involvement will give you broader and deeper experiences in the not for profit sector an appreciation for benefits the Toronto Concert band has within the communities it represents. The TCB will benefit from your expertise, skills and knowledge. The TCB as a whole will also gain from the professional development and additional skills, experience and knowledge you will gain as a result of sitting on the board and immersing yourself in strategic direction and governance of the organization.

About the TCB Board of Directors

The Board of Directors is elected by the membership of the Toronto Concert Band (TCB) and has the statutory power and obligation as granted by the bylaws and constitution of the TCB. The Board sets and monitors the strategic direction of the band. The role of the Board is primarily one of stewardship and strategic visioning but also includes operational support.

- The Board consists of six to ten directors. One seat is designated for a representative from the outside community
- Officers include a President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary who are appointed by the board.
- The Board works within an approved budget and is accountable to the Members.

Eligibility

Any member in good standing may stand for election to the TCB Board if he/she has their nomination properly submitted. Any non-band Member may stand for election for the designated community seat as long as he/she has their nomination properly submitted.

Term of Office

Directors are elected at the TCB Annual General Meeting. A TCB director serves for a term of one year. Vacancies, when they occur mid-term, may be filled by the TCB Board and the positions ratified at the next AGM. Directors may be re-elected annually but according to TCB bylaws not sit in any one position for longer than a 3 years.



Director Responsibilities and Requirements

The Board is accountable to:

- The current and future members of the Toronto Concert Band
- Provincial, federal and other legislation

Fiduciary Duty and Duty of Care

The TCB's fundamental relationship is guided by a fiduciary principle that requires each director to act honestly and in good faith with a view to the best interests of the TCB. In exercising their powers and discharging their duties, every director must exercise the care, diligence and skill that a reasonably prudent person would exercise in comparable circumstances. These principles require a director to put the TCB interests first, avoid conflicts of interest and avoid exploiting business opportunities for self-interest purposes.

Liability

• The Bylaws of the Toronto Concert Band provide for the indemnification of the Directors & Officers of the organization. As a result, the TCB carries Directors & Officers Liability insurance with reasonable limits as determined by the Board.

Compensation

• **Board members are not compensated** and do not receive an honorarium or per diem for participating in board, committee or other meetings, conferences, workshops or assemblies or for representing the Co-Operative.

The Role of the Board of Directors

- 1. Participate in the democratic structure of the TCB (including creating, discussing and voting on proposals and assisting in policy-forming).
- 2. Delegated, by the Members, the authority to exercise all of the Board powers that can be legally exercised between General Members' meetings.
- 3. The authority, as provided by Members, to hold meetings and exercise all of the Member's powers that can be legally exercised between Member meetings.

Participation in Meetings

Directors **Must** be able to attend regular meetings of the TCB Board. Within a one-year period, these normally consist of:

- One board meeting every month during the concert season (meetings are generally 2hrs long)
- · Participation in standing committees or task forces, most of which meet infrequently
- Teleconference or Web conference into regular monthly meeting is permitted if schedule conflicts occur.



Board of Directors Responsibilities include:

- 1. Creating and supporting the vision and strategic direction for the Toronto Concert Band (TCB)
- 2. Planning for the future needs of the TCB
- 3. Overseeing the finances and property of the TCB
- 4. Leading a democratic organization
- 5. Managing the TCB's risk, including legal, financial and reputational
- 6. Employing and evaluating the musical director(s) performance
- 7. Overseeing the committees and task forces of the TCB
- 8. Capitalizing or fund raising for the TCB
- 9. Reporting to the Members on any actions taken on their behalf
- 10. Representing the interests of the TCB and its members in relations with the community, government and special interest groups (arts council, band associations).
- 11. Facilitating a two-way flow of information between the musical director(s), Board members and band membership
- 12. Participation in TCB events, and activities

Board Member Code of Conduct

- 1. Directors have authority only as a Board
- 2. Decisions are only made at duly constituted meetings
- 3. Conflicts of interest are declared
- 4. Open discussion and trust are key
- 5. Confidentiality is maintained
- 6. Leadership is by example
- 7. Demonstrate respect for others
- 8. Directors work for the good of the TCB
- 9. Directors support the decisions of the Board
- 10. Demonstrate tolerance; no discrimination must occur
